Workday Words of the Month: **Default and Allowable Worktags**

For the second tenant build, the project team proposed changes to which worktags will be driver worktags, meaning they determine other values. [Read about proposed changes here.](#) Default and allowable worktags are tied to drivers.

When designing driver worktags, users can select certain worktags as default or available options (meaning users select from a list) when processing transactions. Options other than the default or allowable worktags will not be available or will fail validation.
